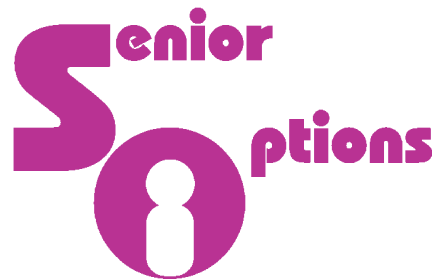

Senior Options Services



INFORMATION AND ADVOCACY Provides resource information on community-based services for older adults to the public.

CASE MANAGEMENT Conducts ongoing assessments and consultations with older adults and their families to ensure the adequacy and quality of community-based services.

ADULT DAY SERVICE Consists of community-based programs designed to meet the needs of functionally impaired adults in a protective setting. Program components include health services, personal care, meals, activities and transportation. Some programs include social work services and rehabilitation therapies.



HOMEMAKER Provides assistance with light house cleaning and laundry to achieve and maintain a clean, safe and healthy environment.

PERSONAL CARE Provides assistance in the performance of necessary activities, such as personal hygiene and grooming.



HOME DELIVERED MEALS Delivers well-balanced meals to the older adult's home to promote adequate nutrition.

CAREGIVER RELIEF (RESPITE CARE) Provides trained individuals to help with the care of older adults who need 24-hour supervision. This provides caregivers with an opportunity to enjoy personal time without worry.



MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION Transports older adults to medical facilities. Wheelchair transportation is available, and one escort may ride with each participant.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE SYSTEMS Monitors an older adult's safety at home and provides access to emergency services through electronic communication devices.
